Senator Katie Britt | Alabama

- Former Chief of Staff for Sen. Richard Shelby (R-AL).
- Campaign Focus: Smaller government, modern job growth, constitutional liberties, and greater economic opportunity.

Senator Britt most recently served as President and CEO of the Alabama Business Council from 2018 to 2021, and she has indicated that she will focus on pro-business policies in her congressional career. Senator Britt has also stated that she will be focused on agriculture, border security, inflation, and crime. She is the first woman elected to serve as a Senator from Alabama.



Senator Ted Budd | North Carolina

- Served six years in the U.S. House of Representatives.
- Campaign Focus: Creating jobs, securing the border, standing with law enforcement, defending the 2nd amendment, and cutting taxes.

While serving his most recent term in the House, Senator Budd was a member of the Committee on Financial Services. He has been dedicated to opposing spending bills proposed by Democrats, and has been a vocal supporter of former President Trump. On the campaign trail, Senator Budd stated that he would be active on gun rights, immigration, and financial issues.



Representative Dale Strong | Alabama's 5th Congressional District

- Previous Chair of Madison County Commission (Seat in Huntsville, AL).
- Campaign Focus: Advance conservative values and Trump-era economic policy, protect law enforcement, and combat illegal immigration.

Rep. Strong was first elected to the Madison County Commission in 1996, and he has served as its chairman since 2012. During his tenure leading the state agency, he was focused on financial development initiatives and disaster response. He has discussed that his top three focal areas will be to combat inflation, boost U.S. energy independence, and protect national security.



Representative Aaron Bean | Florida's 4th Congressional District

- Served eight years in the FL House of Representatives and eight years in the FL Senate.
- Campaign Focus: Economic growth and pro-business policies, conservative values, and workforce growth opportunities.

Rep. Bean has had a long career in state and local politics, having served as a City Commissioner, Mayor, and state legislator. He has run several businesses, because of which he will focus on policies impacting small business and job creation opportunities. Rep. Bean has supported Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, and also previously served under U.S. Senator Marco Rubio (R-FL).



Representative Cory Mills | Florida's 7th Congressional District

- No prior political experience / Served in the U.S. Army.
- Campaign Focus: Bolstering support for the U.S. military, enhancing law enforcement, putting America first, and aligning with Trump-era policies.

Since serving in the U.S. Army from 1999 to 2004, Rep. Mills' career has largely focused on defense and security positions in the private sector. He has most recently been running a military manufacturing company and a private security company – both of which he co-founded. As such, he has emphasized that he will focus on foreign policy, defense, national security, and law enforcement.



Representative Maxwell Frost | Florida's 10th Congressional District



- No prior experience in elected office.
- Campaign Focus: Ending gun violence, Medicare for All, pandemic preparedness, criminal justice reform, and environmental justice.

Rep. Frost has been involved in community organizing since former President Obama's 2012 campaign. He has served as an organizer for the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), and March for Our Lives. As one of the youngest members of Congress, he has stated that he will focus on advancing gun violence reforms, racial justice, and community-based violence prevention.

Representative Anna Paulina Luna | Florida's 13th Congressional District

- No experience in elected office / Served in the U.S. Air Force.
- Campaign Focus: Stopping illegal immigration, restoring energy independence, improving veteran services, and fighting for fair trade.

Rep. Luna previously served in the Air Force from 2009 to 2014, after which she has worked on Hispanic engagement and Hispanic initiatives for various conservative advocacy groups. She has discussed that she plans to be involved in advancing veterans' affairs issues, addressing human trafficking at the southern border, and providing pro-business economic opportunities.



Representative Laurel Lee | Florida's 15th Congressional District



- Former Secretary of State for Florida.
- Campaign Focus: Lower taxes, balanced budget, law enforcement, 2nd amendment protections, pro-family policies, and election integrity.

Rep. Lee has served in government roles in various capacities, including as an Assistant U.S. Attorney, a County Court Judge, and FL Secretary of State. She has been a strong supporter of FL Governor Ron DeSantis' agenda. In her positions thus far, Rep. Lee has been focused on enhancing election infrastructure, cyber defense, law enforcement, and conservative values.

Representative Jared Moskowitz | Florida's 23rd Congressional District

- Currently serving as a Member of the Broward County Commission.
- Campaign Focus: Defending democracy, reproductive rights, the healthcare system, the environment, Israel, and affordable access.

Rep. Moskowitz has previously served as the FL Director of Emergency Management, in the Florida State House, and on the Parkland City Commission. He has emphasized that he will work on climate resiliency programs, gun violence and school safety, disaster mitigation, criminal justice reforms, community safety programs, and animal welfare initiatives.



Representative Rich McCormick | Georgia's 6th Congressional District

- No prior political experience / Served in the U.S. Marine Corps & Navy.
- Campaign Focus: Economic opportunity, law enforcement programs, 2nd amendment rights, patient choice programs, and price transparency.

Rep. McCormick served in the U.S. military for over 20 years, after which he has worked as an Emergency Room Doctor. His campaign messaging has emphasized his positioning as a DC outsider that is committed to conservative American values. He has stated that he will focus on growing economic opportunities, bringing conservatism back to healthcare, and more.



Representative Mike Collins | Georgia's 10th Congressional District

- No previous experience in politics.
- Campaign Focus: Free market economies, individual liberties, limited federal government, law enforcement support, and school choice.

Rep. Collins has owned and operated several businesses, including a trucking company. He has been a vocal supporter of former President Trump, and has positioned himself as a conservative outsider. To that end, he has emphasized his focus on job creation, defending 2nd amendment rights, advancing pro-life policy, and fighting against red-tape and decreasing federal spending.



Representative Morgan McGarvey | Kentucky's 3rd Congressional District

- Served in the Kentucky State Senate for ten years.
- Campaign Focus: Access to affordable healthcare, high-quality public education, economic prosperity, job opportunities, and voting rights.

Rep. McGarvey's public service in the Kentucky State Senate eventually led to him serving as the Senate Minority Leader since 2019. He previously worked as an attorney in both private law offices and for state officials. His key priorities in national office are to protect healthcare and teachers' pensions, promote clean energy, and defend abortion rights.



Representative Don Davis | North Carolina's 1st Congressional District

- Served for ten years in the North Carolina Senate / Served in the U.S. Air Force.
- Campaign Focus: Rebuilding the rural economy, accessible healthcare, veteran support, strong education, environment, and equity & justice.

Before being elected to the state legislature, Rep. Davis began his political career as Mayor of Snow Hill. He has also had a long career as an educator. He has stated that he will further the work he stated in his local-level positions, which include an emphasis on infrastructure, rural healthcare options, increased teacher pay, tax-exempt military pensions, and broadband connectivity.



Representative Valerie Foushee | North Carolina's 4th Congressional District



- Served for ten years in the North Carolina Senate.
- Campaign Focus: Civil rights, criminal justice reform, voting rights & gerrymandering, climate solutions, public health, and education.

Rep. Foushee was originally elected to the North Carolina Senate in 2013, and she has focused on three core issues during her tenure that she plans to bring to her time in the U.S. Congress: education access, job creation, and championing underrepresented communities. She has also worked on immigration issues, voting rights efforts, criminal justice reform, and climate.

Representative Chuck Edwards | North Carolina's 11th Congressional District

- Served for seven years in the North Carolina Senate.
- Campaign Focus: Securing the border, balancing the budget, improving education, advancing pro-life values, and building energy independence.

Prior to being elected to the state legislature, Rep. Edwards has served in various business roles for different companies. These include First Citizens Bank, Henderson County Partners for Economic Progress, and McDonald's. He has stated that he will focus on growing the economy, job opportunities, education options, and responsible financial stewardship during his time in office.



Representative Wiley Nickel | North Carolina's 13th Congressional District



- Served for four years in the North Carolina Senate.
- Campaign Focus: Affordable healthcare, affordable housing, gun safety, environmental protections, economy & jobs, and wage and tax reforms.

Rep. Nickel was originally elected to the North Carolina Senate in 2019. Before this, he worked for former Vice President Al Gore. He is a member of Gore's Climate Reality Leadership Corps. He has also worked in several business and law positions. In U.S. Congress, he will focus on quality public education, reproductive healthcare, rural broadband expansion, and climate solutions.

Representative Jeff Jackson | North Carolina's 14th Congressional District

- Served for eight years in the North Carolina Senate / Served in the U.S. Army and the Army National Guard
- Campaign Focus: Expanding education, combating poverty, taking action on climate change, reforming gun safety laws, and improving healthcare.

Upon returning to North Carolina after his military service, Rep. Jackson worked as a prosecutor in Gaston County, North Carolina. During his time in state office, Rep. Jackson has been a fierce supporter of expanded early childhood education - along with proposals to increase teacher pay, expand Medicaid, pass criminal justice reforms, and act against corruption in government.



Representative Russell Fry | South Carolina's 7th Congressional District

- Served for seven years in the South Carolina House of Representatives.
- Campaign Focus: Improving election integrity, growing the economy, ending human trafficking, and battling the opioid epidemic.

Rep. Fry began serving in the South Carolina House of Representatives in September 2015. He was appointed to the position of Chief Whip for the General Assembly in December 2018. He has been active in efforts to expand school choice, preserve 2nd amendment rights, change voter ID laws, implement term limits, and improve economic circumstances.



Representative Andy Ogles | Tennessee's 5th Congressional District

- Former Mayor of Maury County, Tennessee.
- Campaign Focus: Accountability & transparency, immigration, education, 2nd amendment rights, sanctity of life, and separation of powers.

From 2018 to 2022, Rep. Ogles served as Mayor of Maury County. Separate from his public service, he has operated several restaurants and invested in real estate. He has also served as the COO of Abolition International, an organization for fighting human trafficking. He has stated that he will bring his "principles of limited government, fiscal stewardship, and conservative values" to DC.



Representative Jen Kiggans | Virginia's 2nd Congressional District

- Served for two years in the Virginia Senate / Served in the U.S. Navy.
- Campaign Focus: Cutting inflation, growing jobs & the economy, addressing the border crisis, and prioritizing national security.

Rep. Kiggans was elected in 2020 to begin serving in the Virginia Senate. Prior to this, she was an adult geriatric nurse practitioner in both private practice and at Eastern Virginia Medical School. Before this, she served as a U.S. Navy pilot for ten years. She has been an advocate for mental healthcare affordability, as well as for supporting healthcare accessibility for senior citizens.
